Instructions for 2021-2022

- Please read the entire form before starting in order to organize your responses and avoid any duplication of information.
- To be eligible for nomination, a teacher must have taught for three years in the Denver Public Schools prior to the year of nomination, must be teaching the current year, must be a Colorado licensed teacher, and must not have won this award before.
- One nomination per school will be accepted. Schools listed as K-8 may submit one nomination for a teacher at the K-5 level and one nomination for a teacher at the 6-8 grade level. A teacher must be nominated by at least two people.
- Provide a completed nomination form with answers to the questions listed along with documentation in a portfolio or “memory book” that includes copies of letters, testimonials, and pictures supporting answers to the questions. Letters and information may be obtained from current and former students, faculty, administrators, parents, friends and members of the school community, offering specific examples of excellence. Endorsements from students must be voluntary. Recipients treasure these “memory books,” which they receive following the Excellence in Education banquet.
- Organize the responses to the questions in such a way that the judges may quickly grasp the main answer. Emphasize in specific ways why this teacher is truly superior and unique.
